

Diploma of Facilities Management

Overview

The Diploma has been developed by the Facility Management Association of Australia in conjunction with UNE Partnerships and industry. It is designed to meet the skills and knowledge required for facilities managers who lead, manage and maintain internal and external facility operation teams and services.

This qualification is not recognised under the Australian Qualifications Framework.

Study workload and candidature

The estimated time to complete the Diploma is approx. 6-8 hours per week over a 18-24 month study period - comprising on-the job learning, workplace practice, self-directed study and assessment preparation. This estimate will vary according to personal experience, knowledge and current practices.

Skill outcomes

The Diploma supports facilities managers' training needs to promote, develop, improve and maintain the skills and knowledge required for their roles as facilities managers.

On successful completion of this course, students will have:

- technical skills in the planning, development, implementation of facilities maintenance and lifecycle maintenance programs
- skills in measuring and managing sustainable facilities environments
- managerial business skills, including an understanding of collaboration, interpersonal relationships, stakeholder engagement and delegation
- Risk management skills and an understanding of how to ensure safety in the workplace

Entry requirements

Diploma applicants should:

- be working in a facilities management related environment delivering services and maintenance of operations; or
- have access to a facilities management role in a work-based environment

A combination of knowledge questions, work related tasks and evidence portfolio.

Pathways/industry recognition

Diploma graduates can apply for recognition of prior learning upon enrolment in the UNE Bachelor of Business and Master of Business Administration.
