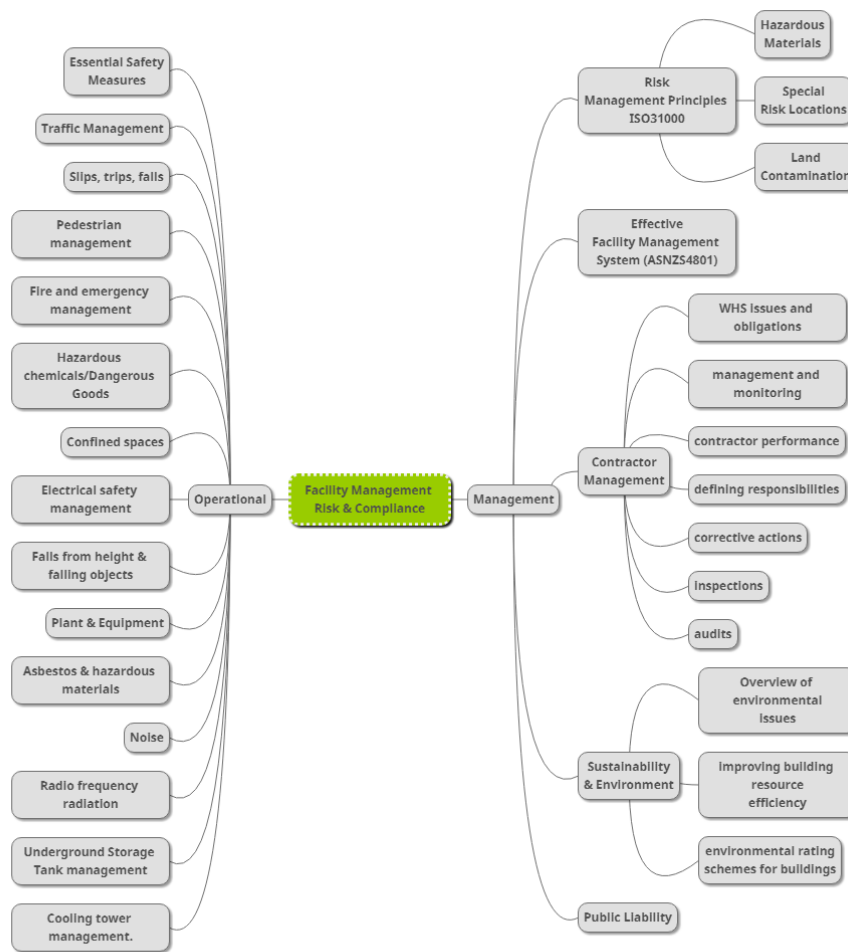
## FM Risk and Compliance Course (2 days)
